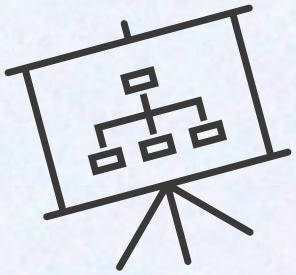

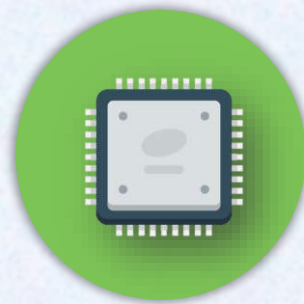

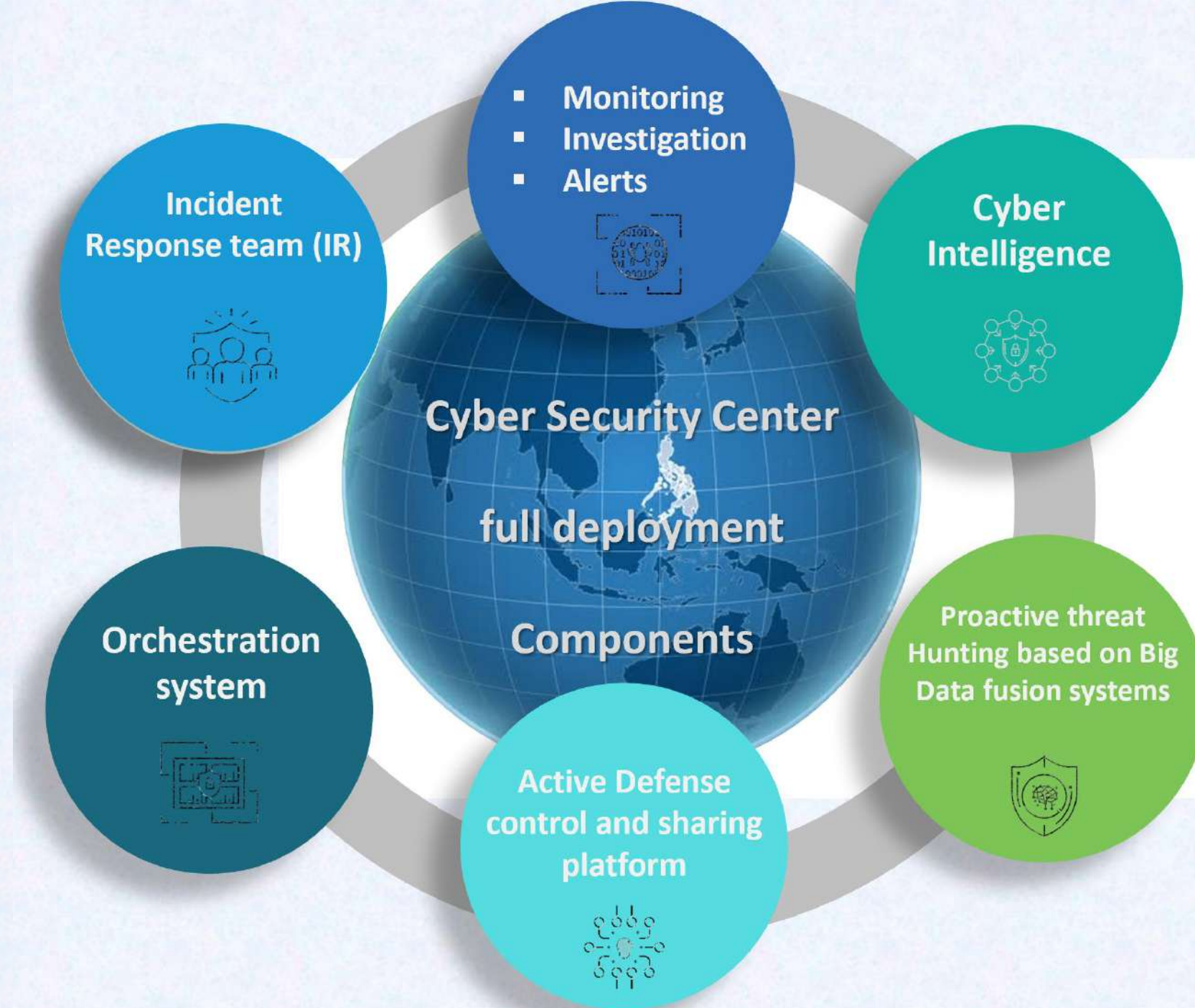

The details of millions of Iranian bank cards were published online after antigovernment protests last month. Experts say it was a state-sponsored cyberattack.

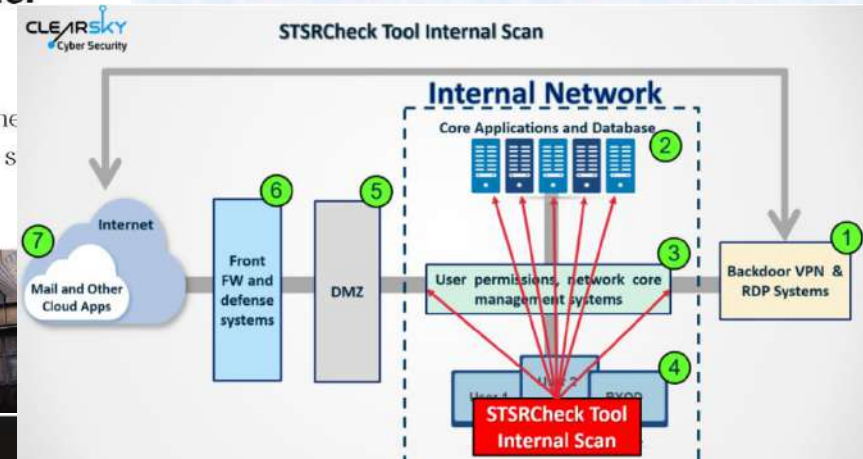
